ein gespräch zweier fremder personen über eine zu erzählende tragische geschichte mit dem thema trauerbewältigung es gilt einen positiven ausgang mit akzeptanz und einem guten gefühl des loslassens zu finden konkret geht es darum dass eltern ihr kind bei geburt verlieren sämtliche phasen der trauer durchleben und schlussendlich eine möglichkeit finden mit einem guten gefühl von trauer und freude gleichermaßen aus diesem teufelskreis zu brechen diese geschichte beruht auf einer wahren begebenheit sowie eigenen persönlichen erfahrungen und erlebnissen

dieses buch berichtet über die geschichtliche entwicklung des bassetthorns von etwa 1760 bis hin zu den modernsten boehm oehler und schmidt kolbe instrumenten neben der darstellung der technischen entwicklung kapitel über mundstücke bahnen blätter ligaturen halterungshilfen und die intonation stellt das buch über 1760 historische und moderne musikwerke mit bassetthorn nebst ihren fundorten vor die über europa die usa israel und australien verstreut sind über 80 komponisten virtuosen und ensembles werden kurzbiographisch vorgestellt neben der technischen beschreibung von über 190 historischen instrumenten vervollständigen mehr als 70 abbildungen das gesamtbild welches das buch vermitteln will

der wiener klarinettist anton paul stadler 1753 1812 ist den meisten musikliebhabern nur im kontext mit mozarts singulären klarinettenwerken ein begriff wer aber war dieser ehemals berühmte den komponisten inspirierende und diesem freundschaftlich verbundene virtuose und freimaurerbruder geboren in bruck an der leitha als sohn eines schusters verlief stadlers leben entlang einer in wien kulturhistorisch faszinierenden zugleich aber von napoleonischen kriegswirren geprägten epoche anton und sein nicht minder begabter klarinettisten bruder johann nepomuk 1755 1804 dürfen für sich beanspruchen sowohl zahlreiche werke mozarts als auch anderer komponisten erstmals gespielt zu haben deren namens galerie ist eindrucklich anfossi beethoven cartellieri cherubini cimarosa dittersdorf druschetzky eberl eybler gyrowetz haydn hoffmeister hummel köcheluch krommer martin y soler paër paisiello righini salieri sefried spontini stammayr vanhal weigl woelfl anton und paul wranitzky dass die stadler brüder als hof und theater musiker alle genannten persönlich kannten ist so faszinierend da den heutigen musikrezipienten nur indirekte zeugnisse ein mehr oder minder wahres lebensbild der zeitgenossen vermitteln auf der grundlage jahrelanger forschungsarbeit beleuchtet der autor selbst klarinettist ungewöhnlich kenntnisreich und kritisch das musikalische und persönliche umfeld anton stadlers eine vita gleichermaßen geprägt von künstlerischen Höhepunkten und bitteren wirtschaftlichen nöten eine fülle bislang unbeachteten oder neu erschlossenen quellenmaterials ermöglicht dabei unzählige neuerkenntnisse und richtigstellungen unter anderem zu wichtigen wiener holzblasinstrumentenmachern zur damaligen wiener konzert und theaterpraxis und den musikerkollegen der brüder stadler
