gendered design an interdisciplinary framework is concerned with the feminist question of how products both digital and physical are and can be gendered by design it proposes gendered design as a conceptual framework for the use of design researchers educators and practitioners to analyze critically reflect on challenge and transform the ways in which design processes and methodologies contribute to the prevalent gender power relations presenting a comprehensive review of the extant feminist work this book distinguishes between the normative and interventional gendered design practices it identifies the explicit and intentional as well as the unreflexively and ultimately careless practices which lead to respectively gender stereotypical and gender blind products this book stresses that the prevalence of such practices should not

prevent us from exploring the interventional forms of gendered design drawing on four case studies gendered design attests that if products have such an important role in gender relations then they can also be shaped in ways that advance gender equity in society by integrating gender sensitive gender responsive gender inclusive and gender transformative considerations into product design processes and methodologies

this was first published in 2000 this work is founded on the premise that many analyses of economic restructuring and of gender relations fail to recognize two things first the situation facing women is different from that of the 1960s when the conceptual apparatuses for analyzing women and work were created labour markets are dominated by flexible non standard work precarious contractual relations and income disparities therefore it is difficult to structure political claims or analysis around the notion that there is a single labour market that the primary problem is discrimination or inappropriate training and that political strategies should focus on discrimination and non traditional employment rather new challenges require new solutions the second point of departure is that is is impossible to understand either contemporary labour markets or the roots of employment and other public policies without locating them vis a vis patterns of gender inequalities generated by and in these labour markets the labour force has been feminized to such an extent that new and often unequal gender relations are crucial to their very functioning

neoliberal policies and austerity measures have unequivocally altered the landscape of women s lives globally the most detrimental effect has been on mothers as they are faced with increasing responsibility and decreasing resources despite mothers being the primary producers consumers and repro ducers of the neoliberal world their centrality has been largely silenced within economic discourse thus mothering in the age of neoliberalism calls for a new economic framework to counter the individualized neoliberal model one in which the needs of mothers and children are prioritized this volume provides a crucial starting point by identifying the sources of neoliberal failure toward mothers we can begin to collectively formulate an alternative paradigm in which mothers voices are no longer rendered invisible but rather predominate in the global landscape

the effects of climate change and climate variability on agriculture pose the greatest challenge for kenya to realize its vision 2030 and other agricultural strategies agriculture is sensitive and highly vulnerable to climate change variability whose effects are already being experienced in life threatening ways given the high dependency on rain fed agriculture people and communities whose livelihoods is conditional on agricultural sector are at higher risk of climatic extremes this manual has been prepared to assist agricultural extension officers and community leaders in disseminating a list of climate smart agriculture practices these set of practices when implemented in an integrated approach should ensure increased production and profitability enhance resilience and adaptation to climate change effects but also promote low greenhouse gas emission though the list of practices are not exhaustive the manual attempt to demonstrate possible effective combination of practices that are suitable for most of the kenyan farming systems and which simultaneously achieve a farming approach that is productive adaptive and with opportunities for carbon sinks each chapter describes a climate smart agriculture practice and tries to respond to the three questions of proposed technologies i e what why and how the format of writing

was intended to make it easy for the users to be able to apply the synergistic implementation of selected practices this manual will be complemented by other manuals and policy guidelines prepared by fao and the government of kenya to support policy makers in integrating climate change concerns in other development areas while achieving food and nutrition security
