women the reverse however a substantial number of men and women are androgynous high in both masculine and feminine characteristics while some are not high in either importantly the authors find that androgynous individuals display more self esteem social competence and achievement orientation than individuals who are strong in either masculinity or femininity or are not strong in either one of the major contributions of the work is the development of a new multifaceted measure of achievement motivation the work and family orientation questionnaire which can be used successfully to predict behavior in both males and females and is related to masculinity and femininity in both sexes in addition to investigating the correlates of masculinity and femininity the authors attempt to isolate parental factors that contribute to the development of these characteristics and achievement motivation the book includes analyses of data from students on their perception of their parents which enable the authors to examine the influence of parental masculinity and femininity and parental behaviors and child rearing attitudes on the development of masculinity and femininity and achievement motivation characteristics in their children the important implications of these findings for theories of sex roles personality development and achievement motivation are examined
